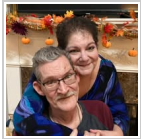

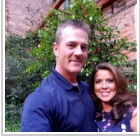

“ ~My Pean was this precious lady in my life that raised me. I know that I'll never be able to thank her enough for all she did for me. She was every bit my Mother. I was raised by her and my Great-Grandmother, Maw-Maw. She took care of me and my brother as babies and little children. Pean would make, not all but some of my clothes, and lots of little dresses. I remember such good meals, an shoe peg corn and a tomato on a plate would be wonderful and we wouldn't complain.

She used to make a sweet treat called a tea cake, so simple to make and us kids loved.

Pean told me, she remembers walking soda bottles to the store to get us our milk when we were babies. She'd buy groceries and they'd mark a book called green stamps, then at the end the year, she take those books and buy our Christmas. Christmas's were wonderful with them, I especially loved her playing her records, Bing C, Perry C, Gene Autry, Burl Ives, and The LeFevres, are ones that come to mind.

She'd take me with her to get her hair done on Saturday mornings, buy me a coke and moon pie and I loved being with her. Taking Leon his supper at the fire station, just up the street and taking a cab to the grocery store and Shoney's, after keeping all those babies and kids all week. She walked me to kindergarten, taking Rice Krispies and sugar in a plastic bag, and milk in a mason jar, for my breakfast.

Pean showed me what love is and how to be the best mother I could become one day. She helped so much with my wedding too. I have 4 children that she loved unconditionally and never missed many birthdays or holiday with us. She even stayed with me after giving birth, till I got on my feet with a couple of them. And she became loved and cherished by my husbands side of the family and touched their heart as much as she did mine.

Pean loved to cook and taught me everything I know about it. And folks love all her recipes that she shared with me. I remember, My Gee would bring bushels of vegetables from her garden and they all three would can them in the Summer.

They lived in a really old home with high ceilings. So they couldn't

afford to heat the whole house, so they'd heat only one room and we'd all pile up in there in the winter. A sweet child she kept, told me yesterday he had the same memory of her warming bricks by the gas stove and wrapping them in newspaper to put at the foot of our bed and then at least five quilts, so we wouldn't get cold.

Pea loved my voice and would want me to sing to her all the time.. She told us things like "Be a light in this dark world", said my singing voice was a gift from God. We didn't have worldly things but most of all we knew we were loved. For that and the things of God she planted in our hearts, I will always be Grateful. She served the Lord daily and at her church and loved keeping the Nursery and rocking those babies.

She was an Angel, My Pea was the most selfless, humble, loving and caring woman that the Lord ever graced this earth with and she got the homecoming that we prayed for, to be at home, peaceful, and with her pride and joy Leon. And I know without a doubt that she entered into Heaven with Jesus holding her hand, and the Savior telling her "Well Done my Good and Faithful Servant!" We told her before she passed, She would be given the most beautiful mansion and oh so many crowns that she has earned. Pea was as close to Mother Teresa as anyone could have ever been... She was loved and will always be loved and forever be missed. I love Pea!!!!~

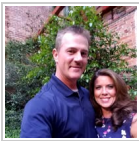

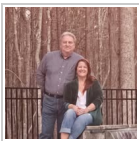
