



## William "Charlie" Bagwell

December 19, 1926 - March 18, 2018

Mr. William "Charlie" Bagwell of Fayetteville passed away on March 18, 2018. Charlie was the owner of Charlie's Trading Post in Atlanta for the past 57 years and an accomplished race car driver having raced in parts of seven decades. He was inducted into the Georgia Racing Hall of Fame in 2006. Not only was Charlie an accomplished race car driver, he also signed a pro baseball contract with the Atlanta Crackers at the age of 17 and a professional bowling contract. Charlie was preceded in death by his adopted son, Mike Bagwell and is survived by his wife, Delores "Dee" Bagwell ; step son , Jeff Chapman and his wife, Angeline of Jasper, GA; step-daughter, Cheryl Chapman of Daytona Beach, FL; grandchildren, Michael Bagwell, Casey Chapman and Solace Duphare. 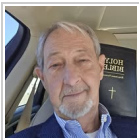
