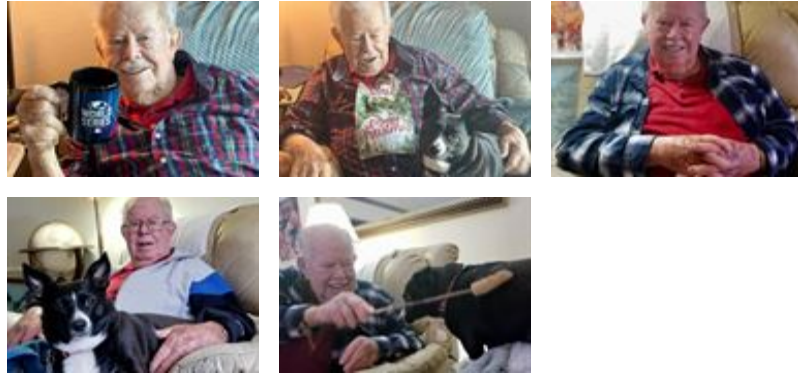
I knew Willie from early in my Delta career working in Overhaul. I remember him being a very nice person and easy to be around and work with. My very best to his family.
